Blues Foundation are the charitable arm of Bedford Blues Rugby Club. We use the values of rugby, sport and exercise to promote health and wellbeing, and positive lifestyle choices through targeted interventions that support our local community across Bedfordshire. Our work aims to improve wellbeing, create inclusive opportunities, and develop skills in young people.

Blues Foundation was launched in April 2020 and have since created several delivery projects that are in their infancy and developing to support our target audiences. Projects include our flagship Tackle LIFE programme, our ABILITY Blues disability sport programme, our Families Project, TRY to Change, and our Holiday Provision.

Responsibilities:

The Activity Deliverer will be responsible for delivering health, wellbeing and multisport related programmes designed by Blues Foundation. Specifically, our ABILITY Blues programme, but with opportunities to deliver on our wider work where appropriate. The role will require delivery of a range of high quality and engaging activities for targeted groups.

ABILITY Blues is our inclusive sport and exercise offer for young disabled people, providing opportunities to be active and experience the wider benefits of being active. The programme is designed to provide inclusive, social and engaging experiences to promote communication, interaction, fundamental movement and core skills.

The successful candidate will be passionate about improving the lives of people from all backgrounds. They will be reliable, hardworking, trustworthy, and willing to work as part of the team for the benefit of Blues Foundation and the wide variety of projects delivered.

Responsible to:

The Activity Deliverer will report to the Foundation Manager in all areas of their work. The role will be based at various locations around Bedford and surround areas, therefore ability to travel is essential.

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- Experience delivering a variety of high-quality exercise sessions, as well as an empathy and understanding towards the target audience.
- Understanding and/or experience of the public health sector, and an ability to articulate key health related messages to participants in a proactive digestible manner.
- Suitable and relevant qualifications and experience in health-related interventions.
- Experience and ability to communicating professionally across different levels and relationships including participants, funders, colleagues and other key partners.
- Ability to deliver at a high standard and to the values of Blues Foundation, as well as an ability to contribute to wider work and impact of the charity.
- Ability to work and deliver in a team environment, as well as individually. The successful candidate should be motivated, demonstrate a positive attitude towards the work of the Foundation.
